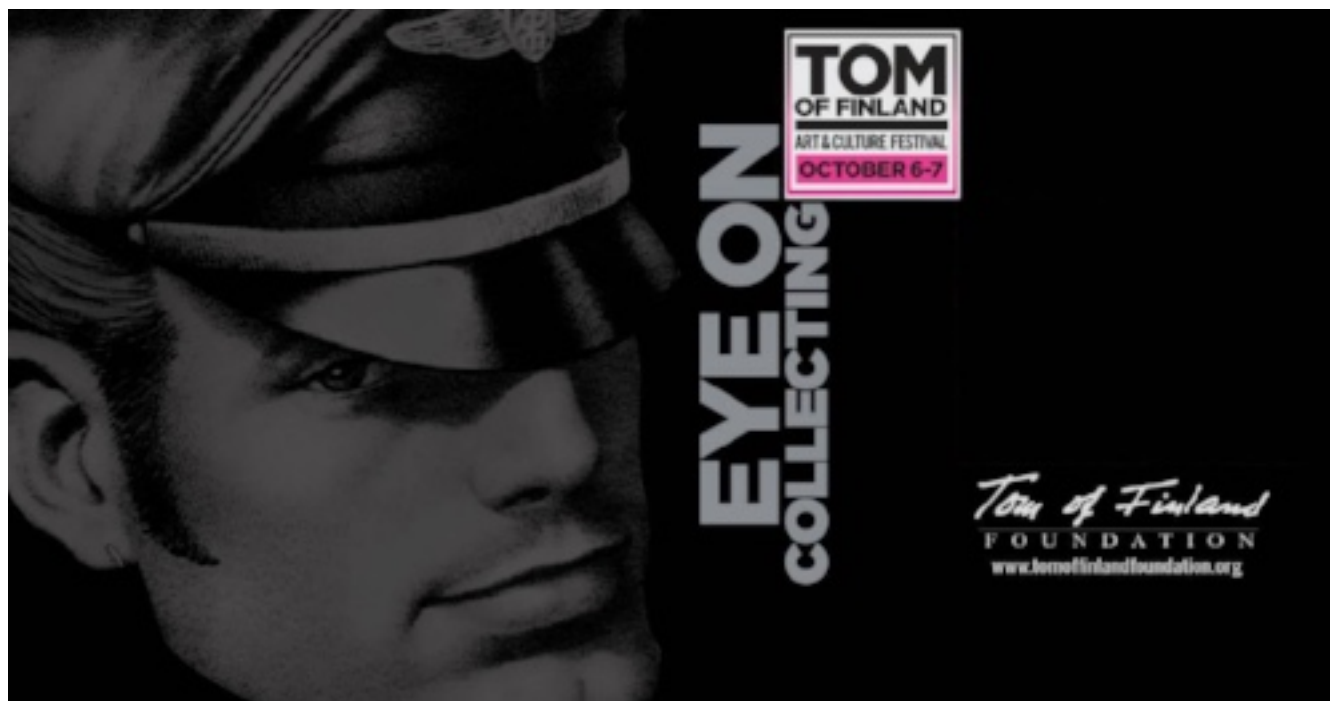

==> **Queer|Art|Prize**

Made possible through Queer|Art's ongoing partnership with HBO, Queer|Art|Prize presents two \$10,000 awards to LGBTQ artists based in the United States: one for Sustained Achievement and the other for Recent Work.

==> **Eva Yaa Asantewaa Grant for Queer Women(+) Dance Artists**

This new \$10,000 grant will be awarded to queer women for making cutting-

edge dance and/or movement-based performance work.

==> **Barbara Hammer Lesbian Experimental Filmmaking Grant**

This annual \$5,000 grant will be awarded to self-identified lesbians for making visionary moving-image art.
