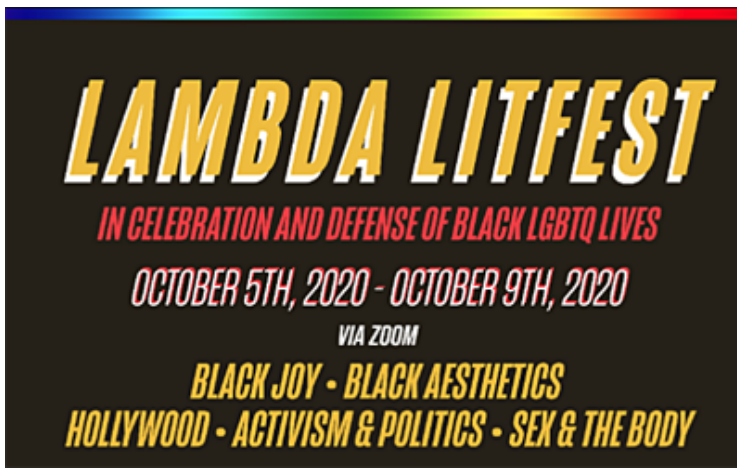

Lambda LitFest: A Celebration & Defense of Black LGBTQ Lives

**A Weeklong Celebration of Queer Black Artistry
October 5-9, 2020**



Lambda LitFest is back for its fourth year with a week-long festival that will celebrate and defend Black LGBTQ lives. Join over 20 BIPOC LGBTQIA+ writers in conversations on art-making, joy, and how to dismantle a white supremacist, ableist, cisgender, heteronormative world.

Events will take place over Zoom and include ASL interpretation.

Lambda LitFest events are free, but registration is required.

Lambda LitFest is supported in part by an Arts Grant from the City of West Hollywood, as well as support from the California Arts Council and the Los Angeles Department of Cultural Affairs.

We are pleased to announce that the GLBT Historical Society Museum will be

reopening for in-person visits starting on Thursday, October 1 for a members only day and on Saturday, October 3 for the general public. In compliance with city and state regulations, to ensure proper social distancing and for everyone's safety, we have implemented new ticketing and visitor policies.

All visits to the museum must be reserved online in advance; we are unable to accommodate walk-ins at this time. Tickets will be timed at hourly intervals, and the number of visitors will be capped at five people per hour. Daily museum attendance is limited to 25 percent of total capacity.

Online Event Hosted by California LGBT Arts Alliance and Oliverio Rodriguez



On Saturday, 19 September, the Alliance proudly presented, with the support of an arts grant from the City of West Hollywood: Oliverio Rodriguez' The Papi Project, a mix media arts lecture and a panel with local artists, activists in conversation on Art, AIDS, Covid and Healing.

The Papi Project was an interdisciplinary project including public collaborative performances, videos, photography, archival images, 3D photographs and writing. A live Zoom panel followed the pre-recorded presentation, and panelists included artist, Oliverio Rodriguez, health specialist, Ethan Patron, community organizer, Luckie Alexander Fuller and Dr. Soto.
