Fall into new artist opportunities! We have compiled the latest residencies, grants, and open calls with deadlines in October and November. Check out The Bennett Prize which supports a woman painter working in figurative realism with a \$50,000 stipend total over two years; the new Rauschenberg Dancer Emergency Grant cycle, providing grants of up to \$5,000 to professional dancers in need; and Hyperallergic's Journalism Fellowship for Curators which comes with \$5,000 to support research and writing.
