Congratulations to Danielle Brazell for her appointment by Governor Newsom as the new Executive Director of the California Arts Council!

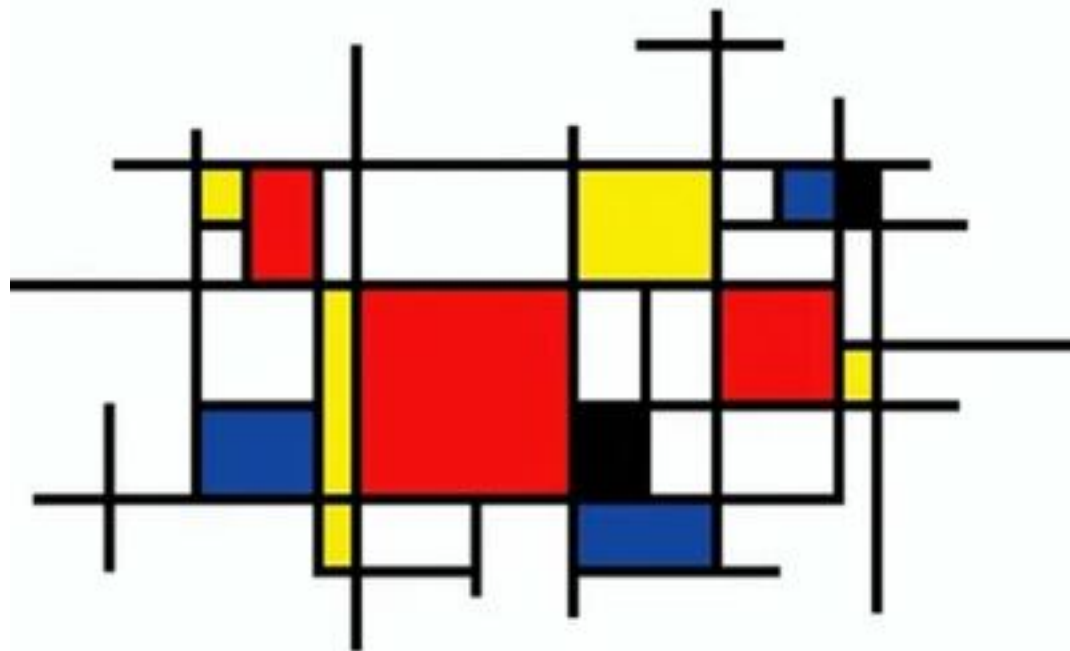
We are thrilled with the appointment of Danielle Brazell. Her selection signals that the Newsom administration clearly values the impact of Arts & Culture and its contributions to state government.
